






OTHER USES AND CUTTINGS OF PADS

A VERSATILE PRODUCT: From one inexpensive MiteGone™ foam pad, you can easily make all of these products by cutting the pad

Treatment	Description	Diagram
21 to 35 day treatment for low and medium infestations	Cut pad in half One per 5 frames of bees	
40 to 60 day treatment for high infestations.	9 ½" pad – cut ½ inch off. One per 5 frames of bees	
Baby and small Nucleus treatment. With one cut as beetle repellent should last 2 to 3 months.	Half pad trimmed. One or two 1" cuts. According to nuk size at sealed end of half pad.	
Hot summer treatment: 2" or 3" cut pads refilled in 2 weeks and reused. Screen bottom board efficacy improvement or beetle deterrent: 1" cut, will last 3 – 4 months.	Full pad – trim corner to reduce the evaporating surface. Install vertically or under a 45° angle.	
Hot humid treatment: For low to medium infestation instead of halves, cut the pad into thirds or quarters. For high infestation use 3 or 4 half pads.	Cut full pad into thirds or quarters to increase evaporating surfaces. Install all pieces in hive.	
Screen bottom board efficacy improvement and/or beetle trap. Soak and put flat (on thin spacers) in your tray without cutting will last 3 months.	Full pad – DO NOT cut or unwrap. Soak and put flat (on thin spacers) in your tray or on bottom board.
